"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened."

~ Matthew 7:7-8

There are people in this world who I love dearly, who I pray for often, and for who I am constantly, continually concerned. Why, you may ask? Well, it's a concern born of the incredible pervasiveness of this material world and its proclivity for wrapping its treacherous tentacles around every human heart birthed into it. It's what King David mentioned when he spoke of being "born in sin" or "brought forth in iniquity" (Psalm 51:5)—that is, completely surrounded by and saturated in a selfish, sin-sick world.

It seems that, the closer I walk with Jesus day-by-day, the more I see what people, even some of those I love, are missing out on. And I want for them all the beautiful things that I get to enjoy in my personal relationship with the Lord—things that no amount of money, or success, or power, or privilege in this present realm can ever buy. Of course, beyond our brief life in this carnal world, I also want them living forever and enjoying life and love with me in that "new heavens and new earth in which righteousness dwells" – (2 Peter 3:13).

I sometimes wish that I could transpose my wants, my desires, my loves, my priorities into

the hearts and minds of others—that I could, somehow, make them want what I want for them. But then I remember, I'm a Bible believer and disciple of Jesus Christ, not a follower of John Calvin; and there's abundant evidence in scripture that even God chooses not to impose His will upon any of us. Rather, He grants us the free moral agency to, as Joshua stated, "...choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve" – (Joshua 24:15).

As Jesus stated in the passage above, God has *soooooo* much in store for those who will ask, those who will seek, those who will knock. But this is something one must do for themselves. Do you remember the old adage: "You can lead a horse to water, but you can't make him drink"? Well, my asking on behalf of someone else, while important to God, only goes so far. Ultimately, people must want for themselves and choose for themselves—either the temporary luxuries and pleasures of this material world or "an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and that will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you" – (1 Peter 1:4).
